DISSATISFACTION OF CGHS SCHEME

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is widespread dissatisfaction in the functioning of CGHS Schemes;
- (b) whether the Government propose to decentralize or revamp the said scheme;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefore;
- (d) whether the Government propose to introduce Group Insurance Scheme or authorize private hospitals to render all medical services including issue of medicines/hospitalization; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. RITA VERMA)

- (a) No, Sir.
- (b)&(c) There is no proposal under consideration of the Government to decentralise the scheme. However, improvement in CGH Scheme is a continuous process and efforts are made from time to time to revamp the scheme.
- (d) There is no such proposal under consideration of the Government.
- (e) In view of (d) above the question does not arise.
