## MINISTER FOR TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI JAGMOHAN)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The Archaeological Survey of India has decided to set up eight museums. Out of these, Jageshwar Museum (Uttranchal) and Sheikh Chilli`s Tomb Museum, Thaneswar (Haryana) have been thrown open to the public, while the other six museums i.e.
- (i) Vikramshila (Bihar);
- (ii) Kangra Fort (Himachal Pradesh);
- (iii) Zanana Enclosure (Karnataka);
- (iv) Guard Room (Karnataka);
- (v) Fatehpur Sikri (Uttar Pradesh); and
- (vi) Residency, Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) are in the process of being set up.
- (c) An expenditure of Rs.40.00 lakh and Rs.40.40 lakh has been incurred during the financial year 2001-02 and 2002-03 respectively for all these museums. Rs.37.00 lakh has been allocated during the current financial year 2003-04.
