(c) & (d) According to the Indian Council of Medical Research and the Central Councils for Research in Ayurveda & Siddhænd Unani Medicine, developed countries are conducting extensive research work on herbs found in India whereafter they are included in the pharmacopoeias of each country and investigated for identifying new drugs of natural origin.
