- (d) if so, the details thereof and the quantum of funds provided through this scheme to the museums during the last three years; and
- (e) the measures adopted to strengthen the network of local and regional museums?

(c) to (e): The scheme was revised during the year 1999, and in the revised scheme, museums under the State Government, were made eligible for financial assistance. From the year 2002-03, University and College Museums will also be made eligible for assistance under the scheme. Under this scheme, the funds sanctioned during the last three years for (i) renovation/repairs/extension/modernisation of galleries; (ii) publication; (iii) conservation laboratory; (iv) museum library; (v) purchase of equipment; and (vi) documentation is as under:
