(a) whether the Government have since completed the examination of the survey report for a new broad gauge line between Wadsa (Desaiganj) and Gadchiroli (49.5 kms.)

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the time by which the examination of the survey report is likely to be completed?

(a) : Yes, Sir.

(b) &(c): The Survey Report for a new broad gauge line between Wadsa - Annori - Gadchiroli has revealed that the cost of construction of this 49.5 kin long line will be about Rs. 76.85 crore with a negative rate of return. In view of the acute resource constraints as well as unremunerative nature of the project, it has not been possible to consider taking up the work for the present.
