(b) On receipt of proposal seeking Central assistance from Government of J & K in 2002-03, a sum of Rs. 44.75 lakh has been provided as Central share for construction of 220 houses and installation of 5 tubewells for the benefit of fishermen and Rs. 3.93 lakh for training and extension activities including training of 250 fish farmer, publication of extension manual and organization of workshop in the State.
