(c) the number of wagons and electric engines are required by railways alongwith the funds required for their procurement;

(d) the number of wagons/electric engines are purchased by the railways alongwith the expenditure incurred thereon;

(b) to (d) The news item refers to the procurement of wagons for next year i.e. 2001-02. The acquisition of Rolling Stock is need based and depends on traffic projections and fund availability. Requirement of wagons for 2001-02 will be finalised at the time of preparation of budget/finalisation of orders. Initial budgetted programme for the year 2000-01 was for 93 Electric Locos at Chittaranjan Locomotive Works at the cost of Rs.409.9 crores. On a review, production of 130 Locos has been projected recently.
