Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Delhi Milk Scheme (DMS) is running in heavy losses presently;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the total loss suffered by the DMS as on March 31, 2003;
- (d) the measures being taken by the Government to minimise the loss?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The losses in DMS are due to decrease in the sale of milk due to increase in the sale price of DMSmilk w.e.f. 1-3-2000, non-utilisation of installed capacity of DMS plant and increase in the processing cost of milk due to increase in input costs.
- (c) The total loss suffered by DMS during the year 2002-2003 is Rs. 16.62 crores (provisional)
- (d) The DMS is adopting professional approaches in different areas of operation such as marketting, transportation, reduction in operational losses and reduction of manpower etc.
