- 2. Gadwal-Raichur 100.41 4.22 5.00 Necessary clearances have been obtained. Final location survey, has been taken up. Land acquisition plans will be prepared after Final Location Survey is over.
- 3. Gulbarga-Bidar 242.42 1.70 2.10 Necessary clearances have been obtained. Final location survey, has been completed and fixing of alignment on the ground has been taken up. Work

construction of bridges have been completed for 30 km length from Hassan end.

Lowering of tunnels and widening of bank in ghat section has been taken up together with geonet treatment to prevent slip and slope failure in ghat section. The Mangalore-Subramaniaghat section is targeted for completion in 2001-02 and the entire section by December 2002, subject to availability of resources.
