- (a) to (e): Investment through Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) is already allowed in the telecom sector within the sectoral caps. A proposal to allow FIIs investment outside the sectoral cap is presently at the discussion level only, in which various aspects, including those relating to security have been included.
- (f) Foreign investment will help in making more resources available for faster development of the telecom sector in the country.
