Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the amount earmarked for Primary Auxillary Health System in the country during the Ninth Five Year Plan;

(b) the number of community Health Centres and Primary Health Centres proposed to be set up in various States during the Ninth Five Year Plan;

(c) the number of Primary Health Centres opened during the last three years so far and the expenditure incurred thereon, State-wise;

(d) whether the Union Government have received any request from the State Governments for restructuring of primary/auxillary health system in the States;

(e) if so, the action taken by the Union Government thereon; and

(f) whether the target set for the first two years of Ninth Five Year Plan have been achieved and if not, the reasons therefore?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. RITA VERMA)

(a): During Ninth Five Year Plan a total of Rs.14,433.85 crores have been allocated towards the State Health Sector by Planning Commission for all States/UTs. This includes provision for Basic Minimum Service Programmes underwhich States have flexibility to choose their priority amongst seven Basic Services including Primary Health Care.

(b): A Statement showing the targets for establishment of Community Health Centres and Primary Health Centresduring the Ninth Five Year Plan is given at Annexure - I.

(c): A Statement showing the number of Primary Health Centres opened during last three years, State-wise isgiven at Annexure - II. These are established and maintained by respective State Governments out of the funds allocated under Basic Minimum Services Programme and Additional Central Assistance provided for the purpose.

(d) &(e): Yes, Sir. Requests for strengthening of State Health System have been received from various States and are under implementation in some of the States with World Bank funding after appraisal by the Government. Reproductive and Child Health Programme is also being implemented in the States which provides for strengthening of Primary Health Care System through provision of drugs, equipments, civil works, training and support staff etc.

(f): The targets and achievement in respect of Rural Health Infrastructure, during first two years of Ninth Five Year Plan, are given below:-
