- (b): During 2002, West Bengal recorded the largest number of incidents of labour unrest followed by Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat.
- (c)&(d): The Industrial Disputes Act,1947 provides a legal framework for maintaining harmonious industrial relations. This facilitates intervention, mediation and conciliation by Conciliation Officers of the Industrial Relations Machinery for resolution of industrial disputes.
