Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have invited applications from NGOs under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan for the year 2003-04;
- (b) if so, the total number of applications received so far, State-wise and location-wise, particularly from Maharashtra; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. SANJAY PASWAN)

(a) to (c): Under the Education Guarantee Scheme and Alternative and Innovative Education (EGS&AIE) component of the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), there is provision for participation of Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) in the programme at State level. Only in case of experimental and innovative proposals in education, NGOs can directly approach the Central Government. In the year 2003-04, Central Government has approved the proposals of seven NGOs including three from WestBengal, two from Delhi and one each from Andhra Pradesh and Assam.
