- (a) whether a cell for the prevention of malpractices has been set up at the A.I.C.T.E. to deal with technical institutions indulging in various malpractices; and
- (b) if so, the number of cases of malpractices that came to the notice of the Cell during the last three years and the action taken against the erring institutions?

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): A High Powered Committee has been constituted by AICTEin September, 2002 to examine complaints received on alleged malpractices by AICTEapproved Technical Institutes and advise measures to be adopted for dealing with such Institutes. More than 350 complaints were received. Show cause notices were issued to 16 Institutions. Finally, two institutions were placed under 'Reduced Intake' category.
