- (b)&(c) This Ministry has received representation from Dr. Pullarao regarding lack ofdrinking water and housing facilities for dispersed tribals in West Godavari district of Andhra Pradesh.
- (d) The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment had deputed one officer toWest Godavari District during November 9-11, 1998 to assess the problems of dispersed tribals.
- (e) The State Government has been advised to utilize a portion of funds out of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub Plan for dispersed tribals to meet their needs.
