- (c) the steps taken by the Government to sanction this project?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b)&(c): The Survey Report for Jhargram-Purulia new line has revealed the cost of this 136.24 km. long line as Rs. 267.65 crore with a negative rate of return. In view of the acute constraint of resources as well as unremunerative nature of the line, it has not been found possible to consider taking up the work.
