- (d) the time by which the double broad gauge line is likely to be provided between Delhi and Rewari?

Answer

- (a): The position is given as under:-
- (i) 90% of the earthwork is over.
- (ii) The work on major and minor bridges is in progress. 11 out of 19 major bridges and 20 out of 80 minor bridges have been completed.
- (iii) Full quantity of ballast has been procured.
- (iv) Modification/extension of platforms at 13 stations is in progress.
- (b):(i) Estimated cost of the project Rs. 69.54 crore.
- (ii) Expenditure incurred till date Rs. 40 crore (approx.)
- (c): Rs. 2 crore.
- (d): Target date has not yet been fixed.
