- (d) whether the Government propose to transfer Krishi Vigyan Kendras under HFC to some other organisations;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (f) whether the Committee set up in this regard has submitted its report; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

- (e) There is a proposal to shift KVKs from Durgapur and Sindri to some other organisation due to the closure of HFC.
- (f) Yes, Sir.
- (g) The committee has recommended transfer of KVKs in Durgapur, West Bengal and Sindri, Jharkhand to Orgram, (campus of West Bengal University of Animal & Fishery Sciences) and Ranchi (Birsa Agricultural University, Jharkhand), respectively.
