Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether an agreement to the effect of laying of telephone lines in rural areas had been reached while awarding licence to private companies in telecom sector last year;
- (b) if so, the names of the private companies which have worked in accordance with the said agreement; and
- (c) the names of states where work has been carried out alongwith the extent of work done?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR)

- (a) Licence Agreements were signed by private companies in 1997-98 whereby they have a contractual obligation to honour their volunteered performance commitments for provision of Village Public Telephones (VPTs) in rural areas during the first three years of their licence period.
- (b) None of the six private licencee companies has provided Village Public Telephones (VPTs) in accordance with these agreements.
- (c) The telephone service has been started by five private licencee companies one each in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Rajasthan. 12 (twelve) Village Public Telephones (VPTs) have been provided by the private company in Madhya Pradesh.
