- (a) whether the Government have received proposals from State Governments seeking central assistance under the centrally sponsored scheme of vocationalization of the secondary education;

- (c) the steps taken by the Union Government on each of these proposal; and
- (d) the number of unemployed youths targeted to be benefited under the said scheme?

(a) to (d) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Vocationalisation of Secondary Education at + 2 level grants are being released to the State Governments for conducting vocational courses based on the proposals received from them, considering the admissibility and availability of funds.
