(b): The National Association of Software and ServicesCompanies (NASSCOM) sees a business opportunity in the Beijing Olympic Hightech Action Plan, which provides for optimization of a batch of projects in the field of traffic and transport, clean energy, environment, protection of the Olympic sports ground and gymnasia, opening and closing ceremonies, science and technology for sports and development of Zhongguancon Science and Technology Park Zone.NASSCOM is exploring the feasibility of cooperation between Indian and Chinese companies for the IT requirements of the 2008 Olympic games.

(c): The opening up of services sector, especially with reference to the movement of professionals and natural persons was discussed and it was agreed to adopt a coordinated approach in the forthcoming round of WTO negotiations in this regard.
