- (b) At a summit meeting in Moscow last month, US and Russia agreed through a joint MOU to establish a Joint Data Exchange Centre for exchanging data generated by the two countries` space and ground based warning systems on launches of missiles or Satellite Launch Vehicles. This would be expanded through a phased programme to include exchange of information on launches conducted by other States. The MOU also refers to the creation of conditions for a database that can be used as part of a multilateral regime.
