(a) whether there is any proposal to expand Bathinda Cantonment and Ammunition Depot;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether there is a prescribed limit of distance between an ammunition Depot or Cantonment and civil population area;

(d) if so, the limits prescribed therefor;

(e) whether it is a fact that in the name of expansion of Bathinda Cantonment and ammunition Depot, these limits are being overlooked;

(f) if so, whether as a result of this expansion a large number of civil population, institutions at Bathinda are being faced with the danger of evacuation from their own houses; and

(g) if so, the details of the Government's plan to provide relief to the proposed oustees?
