(a) & (b): The Services are celebrating Vijay Diwas on 16th December every year to commemorate Indian Armed Forces Victory during 1971 Operations. As recommended by the services, it has been decided to celebrate only one Vijay Diwas on 16th December to pay homage to our martyrs. In view of this the Government have decided not to commemorate the fourth anniversary of the Kargil Day.
