- (b) if so, the amount earmarked therefor and the amount spent thereon; and
- (c) the details of the steps taken to improve the Grand Trunk Road?

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The cost of sanctioned projects on GT Road is Rs.6605 crores and Rs.1997 crores have been spent till 31-7-03.
- (c) Under National Highway Development Project, NH-I from Delhi to Jalandhar andNH 2 from Kanpur to Kolkata hasbeen mandated to be 4/6/8 laned. In addition 4-laning of 20 km. stretch from Jalandhar towards Amritsar (km. 387.1 to 407.1 of NH I) is targeted to be taken up in next phase of NHDP. The remaining stretches of G.T. Road including NH-91 (Ghaziabad-Kanpur) are being improved in phased manner.
