(a)& (b) 82 proposals regarding inclusion of certain castes in the list of Scheduled Castes have been received from various State Governments and Union Territory Administrations during last three years and till date. The State /Union Territory wise number of said proposals received and their current status is mentioned in the Statement attached. Out of 82 proposals, one proposal of Government of Punjab has been included in the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950. Remaining proposals are in different stages of processing as per approved modalities. The proposals are required to be processed in consultation with various agencies, therefore, no time frame can be assigned for finalizing these proposals.
