- (c) the time by which the above project is likely to be completed?

- (i) Doubling from Ghaziabad to Muradnagar has already been completed and doubting from Muradnagar to Meerut City is in progress.
- (ii) Survey work for doubling from Meerut to Saharanpur is in progress.
- (iii) At present there is no proposal for doubting between Saharanpur- Dehradun.
- (b) The estimated cost and expenditure of Murad Nagar-Meerut City doubting project is as under:-

Estimated cost - Rs. 61.37 crores.
Expenditure incurred upto date - Rs. 29.00 crores

(c) The doubling project from Murad Nagar to Meerut City is likely to be completed by December, 2000.
