- (c) the reasons for not filling up the vacant posts of S.E./MIS Division of N.B.O. since 1992?

- (a)&(b): The Expenditure Reforms Commission, aftermaking a thorough review of the performance of National Building Organisation, over the last few years, has recommended closure of National Building Organisation. The Government has accepted the recommendation and decided to close down National Building Organisation.
- (c): In view of the above, the question of filling up vacant posts would not arise. Moreover, these posts had already come under 'deemed abolition' clause with effect from 1993.
