- (a) whether USA has recently given any indication that export quota for readymade garments from India will be increased only when American garment industry gets marketing facilities in India on mutual basis; and
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI BASANAGOUDA R. PATIL (YATNAL)

- (a) No, Sir. As per World Trade Organisation (WTO) Agreement on Textiles and Clothing (ATC), the quantitative restrictions (import quotas) would be completely phased out and textile sector fully integrated by 1st January 2005. All WTO Members including USA are bound by this obligation.
- (b) Does not arise, in view of (a) above.
