(a) & (b)Yes, Sir. A scheme of National Overseas Scholarship (NOS) for ST students was being implemented by this Ministry. At present this scheme is not in existence. The selection of the students under this scheme was made upto the year 2000-2001. Out of the selections so made, a total of 5 students have been sent abroad during the last three years including the current year.
