- (a) & (b): Many State Governments have been facing cash imbalances due to mismatch in their receipts and expenditure. A statement on financial position of the State Governments as per Reserve Bank of India records is annexed.
- (c), (d) & (e): Government of Manipur requested for conversion of Medium Term non-plan loan amounting to Rs.371 crore sanctioned by the Government of India during last year into one time grant to tide over financial problem faced by the State Government . It has not been found feasible to accede to this request.
