- (c) whether the Government are contemplating to make it mandatory for all Government, private buildings, commercial complexes and multi-storeyed apartments to instal rain water harvesting system; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the concrete measures being taken by the Government in this regard?

TATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d)DF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.289 FOR 15.03.2000 I SHRI SURESH RAMRAO JADHAV AND NARESH PUGLIA - REGARDING WATER MANAGEMENT.

The Central Ground Water Board has conducted artificial recharge experiments in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, Union Territory of Chandigarh and NCT of Delhi. The new areas for artificial recharge experiments have been identified in eleven States of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu& Kashmir, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal and NCT of Delhi. The State-wise list of new areas identified for artificial recharge experiments in various States is indicated in the Annexure.

With a view to promoting the roof-top rain water harvesting, the Ministry of Water Resources has proposed to the Ministry of Urban Development and the local bodies like Delhi Development Authority and Municipal Corporation of Delhi to consider making suitable regulations for roof-top rain water harvesting for Delhi and other cities by the organisations/agencies concerned.
