(a) Yes Sir.

(b) Development of National Highways is a continuing activity. An allocation of Rs.10.00 crore has been made by the Ministry to the State Government for development of National Highway - 39 and 150 in Manipur during 1999-2000. In addition to this Border Roads Organisation has allocated Rs.0.45 crore for development of National Highway - 39 from Mao to Maram and Rs.07.13 crore for development of National Highway-53.
