## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether AC first Class/coupe service is not available in Rajdhani Express plying on Delhi-Dimapur route between Guwahati Dimapur section;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which AC first Class services on this train is likely to be introduced?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) 2423A/2424A New Delhi-Guwahati-Dibrugarh link Rajdhani Express is running with maximum permissible load of 18 coaches that a diesel locomotive can haul. Attachment of IAC coach will be feasible only as a replacement of existing AC 2-tier/AC 3-tier coaches, which are fully patronised. Replacement of the existing AC 2-tier/AC3-tier coach by IAC coach will not be acceptable to the existing users. Further as per present utilisation there is no commercial justification for attaching additional IAC coach on 2423A/2424A New Delhi-Guwahati-Dibrugarh link Rajdhani Express.
