## Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the CBI has busted a racket involved in leakage of question papers pertaining to the Common Admission Test (CAT) for entrance to premier management institutes;

(b) if so, the facts thereof;

(c) the number of persons arrested by the CBI;

(d) the persons held responsible for leaking question papers;

(e) the action taken against such persons; and

(f) the steps taken by the Government to check, the recurrence of such incidents?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (Dr. Vallabhbhai Kathiria)

(a) to (e): Yes Sir. CBI has busted a racketof leakage of question papers. It was observed that S/Shri ArunKumar, Kumar Suman Singh, Manoj Kumar and Hari Shankar Chaudhary in conspiracy amongthemselves and other unknown persons procured CAT question paper by theft or criminal breach of trust. A regular case has been registered by CBI.

(f): The Ministry has also set up a Committee under the chairmanship of Shri V.K. Shunglu, Ex-C&AGto examine the circumstances which led to leakage of question paper and to see whether there was any systemic failure, to fix responsibility on those persons/Agency responsible for the leakage of question paper and to examine the methodology of conduct of CAT examination and suggest measures to avoid recurrence of such instances in future.
