(a), (b) & (c) On the analysis of the tidal data collected during the past 100 years at tidal observatory located at Appolo Bandar, Mumbai, the rising trend of less than half a millimeter in sea level at the observatory is noticed. The trend is not significant to draw any definite conclusion.
