(b) if so, the details of the projects so outstanding?

(a) Yes, Sir. Investments proposed in Maharashtra by way of Industrial Entrepreneur Memorandum (IEM) filed and Letters of Intents (LOIs) granted between August, 1991 to September, 2003 were highest in the country at Rs.233511 Crs. (IEMs) and Rs.12764 Crs. (LOI) aggregating to Rs.246275 Crs.

(b) Total number of projects proposed during this period in Maharashtra were 10102 (IEMs) and 551 (LOIs).
