(a) and (b): In the Sarkaria Commission Report, there are in all 247 recommendations of which 170 recommendations have been implemented and 20 recommendations are at various stages of implementation in the administrative Ministries/Departments. The remaining 57 out of 247 recommendations of the Sarkaria Commission have not been accepted by the Inter-State Council or the administrative ministries concerned. The Inter-State Council Secretariat is closely monitoring implementation of the recommendations which have been accepted by the Inter-State Council/administrative ministries.
