CONSTRUCTION OF WAREHOUSES ON RAILWAY LAND

## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Railways have formulated a scheme to allot railway land to private/public sectors to build warehouses near railway stations;
- (b) if so, the names of the places identified therefor, State-wise;
- (c) the terms and conditions of such land lease; and
- (d) the names of private/public sector units who came forward to build warehouses?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI O. RAJAGOPAL)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) At present, a pilot project has been approved at Whitefield, Bangalore for construction of a Warehouse by Central Warehousing Corporation on railway land. Other places for similar construction would be identified based on traffic potential and need.
- (c) The broad terms and conditions of the contract include the following:
- (i) Railways will provide land for a period of 20/30 years which may be extended further.
- (ii) The promoter should have requisite expertise & experience in execution of Warehousing projects.
- (iii) The promoter will be required to give preference to rail borne traffic.
- (d) The private/public sector units who had come forward include:
- (i) Madhya Pradesh State Warehousing Corporation (MPSWC) in the public sector.
- (ii) M/s. Mahihar Cements, Satna, in the private sector.
