Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a pressing public demand for provision of an over-bridge across the railway track near Ramawadi Railway Station under South Central Railway;
- (b) whether any representation has been received from any Member of Parliament in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the action taken by the Government thereon?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a) to (c): No, Sir. There is no demand from the State Govt. for any Road Over Bridge at Ramawadi. However, there was a demand from VIPs/Elected representatives for an underbridge near Ramawadi station of Central Railway which has already been fulfilled by allowing use of an existing culvert as an under bridge. Additional facility can be considered on receipt of firm proposal sponsored by State Govt. as per extant rules.
