## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of land sliding cases reported during the last three years along rail line in Southern Railway including Konkan Railways;
- (b) the places where rail traffic was disrupted due to this land slide;
- (c) the loss of life and property on this account;
- (d) the total expenditure incurred by Indian Railways for repair, restoration of remedial works; and
- (e) the steps being taken by the Government to avoid such land sliding in future?

- (a) 125
- (b) Traffic was disrupted in Southern Railway on Trivandrum-Nagercoil Section, Mettupalayam- Udhagamandalam section and on Konkan Railway at 4 places.
- (c) Nil
- (d) Rs. 26.64 crores.
- (e) Remedial measures depend upon site conditions and vary from case to case. In general, following steps are being taken to avoid occurrence of land slides on both the Railways:-
- 1. Flattening of side slopes in cuttings
- 2. Diversion of water and sewage pipe lines away from cuttings.
- 3. Repairs to side drains, catch water drains and improvement of drainage in vulnerable cuttings.
- 4. Provision of retaining walls where ever required.
- 5. Provision of reinforced earth gabion for slipped critical portions.
- 6. Cut and cover where required.
