CONSTRUCTION OF OVER BRIDGES

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are aware of the problems being faced by the public due to absence of over bridges at Manauri, Bharwari and Siradhu railway stations in Kaushambi district;
- (b) whether accidents often take place at the said railway stations while crossing the railway line due to absence of over bridges; and
- (c) if so, the time by which these are likely to be constructed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a) to (c) No, Sir. However, Foot Over Bridge connecting platforms at these stations have been provided for use of bonafide Railway passengers. Foot Over Bridge at Manauri was damaged some time back after being hit by a wagon with open door. Action has been initiated to get it repaired.
