#### Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has identified eligible blocks under the Area Intensive Programme for educationally backward minorities in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, state-wise;
- (c) whether steps have been taken to give adequate representation to the muslim population in these eligible blocks;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the actual expenditure incurred and the number of beneficiaries under the programme during the last three years, year-wise and state- wise?

### **Answer**

- (a) Yes Sir.
- (b), (c) & (d): Area Intensive and Madrasa Modernisation Programme (AIMMP) which was formed the Xth Planby the merger of two schemes of Area Intensive Programme for Educationally Backward Minorities and the Financial Assistance for Modernization of Madrasa Education is being implemented in 325 blocks across the country and 4 districts of Assam of concentration of educationally backward minorities. State-wise details are given in Annext-I. The identification of concentration of educationally backward minorities has been done by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment based on 1981 census using the criterion that such blocks/districts should have 20% or more Muslim population.
- (e) The actual expenditure incurred and the number of beneficiaries year-wise and state-wise under the programme during the last three years is as follow:
