(a) & (b) : During the Quarterly Performance Review Meeting held in October, 2003, Planning Commission noted slow progress of plan expenditure in respect of some projects/schemes of the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals in the Ministry.

(c) : Plan expenditure was at a slow pace in the first two quarters of 2003-04 in respect of Central Institute of Plastics Engineering& Technology (CIPET), Institute of Pesticides Formulation Technology (IPFT), Hindustan Organic Chemicals Limited (HOCL), industan Insecticides Limited (HIL) and Hindustan Antibiotics Limited (HAL).

(d) & (e) : The Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals is closely monitoring the progress of plan expenditure.
