The vacancies are kept in the higher grades to accommodate the persons to be promoted and who would be reverting from deputation. For the entry grade (Junior Time Scale), the direct recruit vacancies are reported to Union Public Service Commission and the promotion vacancies are filled up by promotion from Group `B` as per rules.
