## Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to set up a National Institute for research and training in Tribal Affairs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith its constitution and mode of functioning thereof;
- (c) the performance of the State level Tribal Research Institutes in the development schemes during the last two years; and
- (d) the total funds allocated to implement various schemes as well as for the special central assistance to tribal sub-plan?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS SHRI JUAL ORAM (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Details are not finalised.
- (c) The performance of States` Tribal Research Institutes for the last two years is reported to be satisfactory. These Institutes undertake research, evaluation and monitoring of various programmes/schemes related to tribal development. These Institutes also organise training, seminars/workshops and publish books related to tribal development.
- (d) Under Central and Centrally Sponsored Schemes, an allocation of Rs.630.00 crores has been made for various programmes for Scheduled Tribes in States/UTs. Out of this allocation, a sum of Rs. 400.00 crores has been provided under Special Central Assistance (SCA) to Tribal Sub Plan during the current financial year.
