(a) & (b): Electricity is a concurrent subject. Supply and distribution of electricity in a State including cities is the responsibility of the State Government/State Power Utilityconcerned. Load shedding is resorted to on day-to-day basis by the States/State utilities depending upon the demand vis-Ã -vis availability of power. No statutory cuts have been reported during the month of December, 2003 in the NCT of Delhi, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra.
