- (d) the likely amount to be generated as a result thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI NITISH KUMAR)

- (a): Railways do not have any land surplus to its requirement. Railways have, however, with a view to generate income from internal sources, taken up commercial utilisation of some of railway land/air-space, which is not needed in immediate future.
