(a) to (c) In continuation of Prime Minister's initiative of April 18 and the step by stepapproach adopted to normalise diplomatic and other links with Pakistan, India, on 23 September 2003, proposed to Pakistan an increase in the staff strengths of the respective High Commissions by 8 on a reciprocal basis. Pakistan has agreed to the Indian proposal.
