THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI VINOD KHANNA)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The Summit (Putrajaya) Declaration did not contain references to any country / regional issues (including J&K).However the OIC Summit Communiqué, the Statement of the OIC Secretary General, Declaration of the OIC Contact Group on J&K and other routin OIC Resolutions contain references to J&K as in the past but with incremental changes.
- (c) The OIC has no locus standi in matters concerning internal affairs. The Government of India therefore rejects all such resolutions and references outright.
